

Detailed Step-by-Step Guide for Teachers on Penexam

Step 1: Open Website

1. Open your browser and go to penexam.com.
2. Scroll down to the **bottom (footer section)** of the homepage.

Step 2: Access Teacher Panel

1. In the footer, click on “**Earn with PenExam**”.
2. On the page that opens, click on the link “**Access Teacher Panel**”.
 - o This will take you to the **Teacher Panel portal**, where teachers manage their tests.

Step 3: Create Teacher Account

1. On the Teacher Panel page, click “**Create Account for Teacher Panel**”.
2. Fill in the registration form carefully:
 - o **Full Name**
 - o **Email ID** (use the one you will log in with later)
 - o **Password**
 - o **Academy Name** (your institution or personal brand)
3. **Upload Academy Logo** 
 - o This logo will appear with your test series, so make sure it is clear and professional.
4. After filling all details, click **Submit / Create Account**.
5. Your Teacher account is now created.

Step 4: Login to Teacher Panel

1. On the Teacher Panel page, click “**Login**”.
2. Enter your registered **Email ID** and **Password**.
3. After successful login, you will reach the **Teacher Dashboard**.

Step 5: Teacher Dashboard Overview

- The **Teacher Dashboard** is your control center.
- On the **right-hand side of the panel**, you will find important links:
 - **Add Test Series**
 - **Add Sub-Test Series**
 - **Add Questions**
 - **Upload Questions**
 - **Categories Test Series**

Step 6: Add a Main Test Series

1. Click “**Add Test Series**”.
2. Fill in details for your test series:
 - **Test Series Name** (e.g., “Medieval History NCERT 6th to 12th”)
 - **Description** (overview of syllabus, chapters, or topics covered)
 - **Price** (amount users must pay to unlock full access)
 - **Validity** (time period the user can access after purchase – e.g., 1 month, 6 months, 1 year)
3. Click **Save**.
4. Your **Test Series** is now created.

Step 7: Add Sub-Test Series (within a main test)

1. Click “**Add Sub-Test Series**” from dashboard.
2. Select the **parent Test Series** you just created.
3. Enter details for each **Sub-Test**:

- **Sub-Test Name** (e.g., “Medieval India – Delhi Sultanate”)
- **Free or Paid:**
 - You can choose whether the sub-test will be free or paid.
 - **Recommended:** Make the **first 2 sub-tests Free** so users can check quality.

4. Click **Save**.
5. Repeat to create multiple sub-tests under your main series.

Step 8: Add Questions

There are **two methods** to add questions:

A. Add Questions Manually

1. Click **“Add Questions”**.
2. Enter the number of questions you want → click **Generate Field**.
3. For each question, fill details:
 - **Question Text**
 - **Option A, Option B, Option C, Option D**
 - **Correct Option** (select A/B/C/D)
 - **Explanation / Solution** (optional but recommended for clarity)
4. Select the **Test Series** and **Sub-Test Series** in which these questions should appear.
5. Click **“Add Questions”**.
6. Your questions are now live on penexam.com. 

B. Upload Questions in Bulk (via Excel template)

1. Click **“Upload Question”**.
2. Download the **Excel Template file**.
3. Open template in **MS Excel** and fill each row as follows:

- **Column 1:** Question
- **Column 2:** Option A
- **Column 3:** Option B
- **Column 4:** Option C
- **Column 5:** Option D
- **Column 6:** Correct Option (write A / B / C / D)
- **Column 7:** Solution / Explanation (optional)

4. Save the file in .CSV format.
5. Back on the website:
 - Select **Test Series**
 - Select **Sub-Test Series**
 - Upload the Excel file.
6. Questions will automatically be added and visible on PenExam. 

Step 9: Categorize Sub-Test Series

1. Click “**Categories Test Series**” from the dashboard.
2. Select the **Test Series** you want to categorize.
3. You will see a list of its **Sub-Tests**.
4. Tick  the sub-tests you want to group together.
5. Enter a **Category Name** (e.g., “Unit I – Early Medieval India”).
6. Click **Add Category**.
7. Now those sub-tests appear under the new category.

Step 10: Final Checklist

Before publishing, make sure:

- Academy Logo uploaded
- Test Series added with proper **Name, Description, Price, Validity**
- Sub-Tests created (first 2 set as **Free**)

- Questions added (manually or uploaded via Excel)
- Categories created for better organization
- Previewed tests to check everything is correct

Tips for Best Results

- Always **write clear descriptions** of your test series to attract more users.
- Provide at least a **few free tests** so students can judge your quality.
- Use **detailed solutions** for questions – students value learning, not just answers.
- Update and add new sub-tests regularly to keep your series active.
- Promote your test series link among students to increase visibility.
